1 Typeset Text

Please use the following styles:

- Title: for the main title of your paper, max. 2 lines, in Helvetica 24-point, single line spacing, centred
- Authors: for the First Names, optional Middle initials, and Last Names of the authors, max. 2 lines, in Times 14-point, single line spacing, centred, 12 points line before
- Affiliation: for authors' affiliations, max. 2 lines, in Times 13-point, 15 points line spacing, centred
- Address: for authors' affiliations, max. 2 lines, in Times 13-point, 15 points line spacing, centred
- Email: for authors' email addresses max. 1 line, in mono-spaced font (e.g., Courier) 13-point, 15 points line spacing, centred
- Abstract: for a short summary of the paper, max. 150 words, in Helvetica 11-point, 13 points line spacing, justified, 12 points lines before and after
- Heading – first level: for headings of major sections, max. 2 lines, in Helvetica 17-point, single line spacing, centred, 24 points lines before and 12 points after
- Heading – second level: for headings of second level sections (e.g., 1.1), max. 2 lines, in Helvetica 15-point, single line spacing, centred, 18 points line before and 9 points after
- Heading – third level: for headings of second level sections (e.g., 1.1.1), max. 2 lines, in Helvetica 13-point, single line spacing, centred, 12 points line before and 6 points after

- Body text begin: for the first paragraph of each section, in Times 13-point, 17 points line spacing, justified
- Body text: for all following paragraphs of each section, in Times 13-point, 17 points line spacing, justified, 0.5 cm first line indentation
- Figure: for images in grey scale (usually 300 dpi), 18 points line before, centred (please keep the figure and its caption together on one page)
- Caption: for short description of figure, Times 11-point, 13 points line spacing, 12 points line before and 12 points after (please keep the figure and its caption together on one page)
- Bullet: for all items of bullet lists, in Times 13-point, 17 points line spacing, justified, 0.5 cm first line indentation 0.5 cm hanging
- Acknowledgements: for personal thanks, in Times 11-point, 13 points line spacing, 2 points line before and 2 points after, justified
- References: for all items of the reference list, sorted by author names and years, numbered with numbers in brackets, in Times 13-point, single line spacing, justified, 0.81 cm hanging
- Footnote Text: for optional short comments at the end of the page, numbered, in Times 11-point, 10-points line spacing, 2 points line before, justified, 0.81 cm hanging
